International Easter Regatta

26, 27 and 28th of March 2016 Kagerplassen near Warmond.

1 Organizing authority

The races will be organised by the KWV De Kaag in conjunction with the Cadet Association “DCCA” and the Yngling Association “Yngling Club Holland.

2 Rules

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016. The prescriptions of the Dutch National Authority will apply, together with the Class Rules of the attending classes. The Sailing Instructions may change some rules.
- 2.2 Every person on board who has its domicile in the Netherlands shall have the required licenses. The licences will be checked before or upon registration.
- 2.3 Each boat that enters the regatta must have a valid measurement certificate.

7 Registration en Raceschedule

- 7.1 Registration shall take place on Saturday the 26th of March between 9.00 and 10.30 hours at the Information desk in the Kaagsociëteit.
- 7.2 Each boat shall confirm his entry for the regatta at the regatta office before the start of his first race. The following should be submitted during registration at the regatta office:
Crew list with all crewmembers licence numbers for crew members living in the Netherlands (NoR 2.2)
A copy of a valid Race licence for the responsible person on board (NoR 2.2)
A copy of a valid measurement certificate issued not later than 5 days before the date of the first race
- 7.3 De races are scheduled as followed:

Cadet Class:

Saturday the first scheduled start is at 11:00 hrs, Sunday at 11:00 hrs and Monday at 10:00 hrs.

Scheduled are:

Saturday and Sunday one race in the morning and two races back-to-back in the afternoon.

Monday two races in the morning back-to-back.



Yngling Class:

Saturday the first scheduled start is at 11.15 hrs. On Saturday two races back-to-back.

Sunday the first scheduled start is at 11.15 hrs and Monday the first scheduled start is at 10.15 hrs.

On Sunday two races in the morning back-to-back, two races back-to-back in the afternoon.

On Monday two races in the morning back-to-back and one race in the afternoon.
